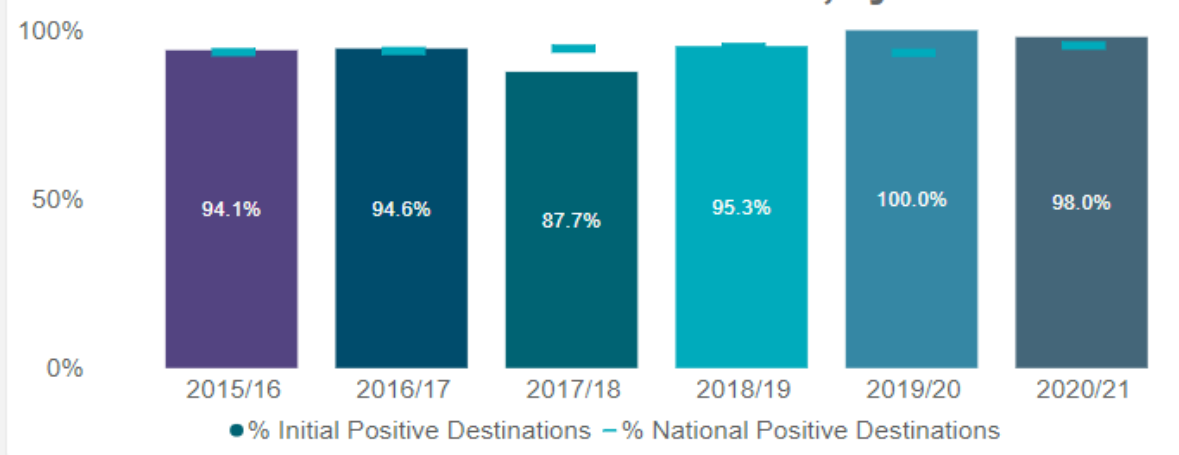

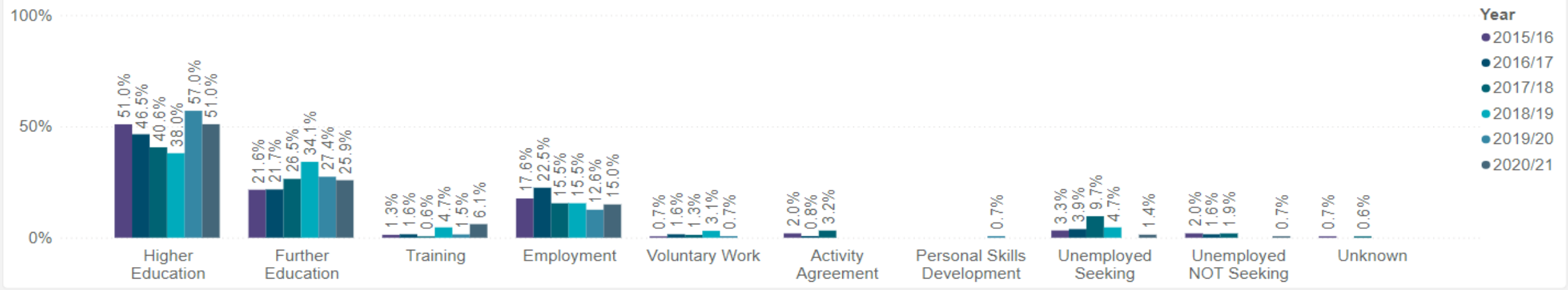

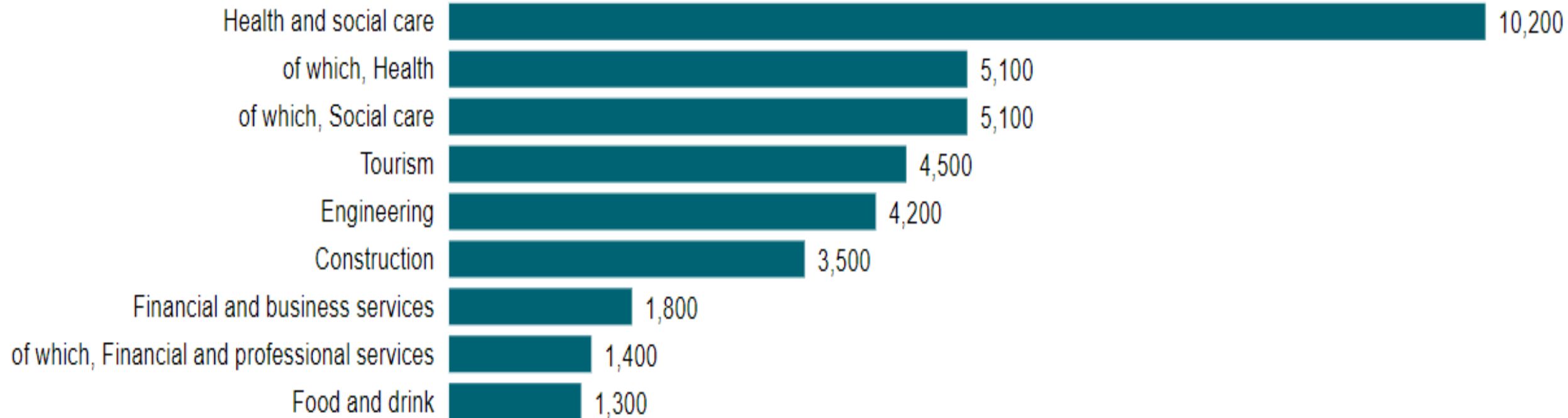

Employment Forecast by Industry (people)



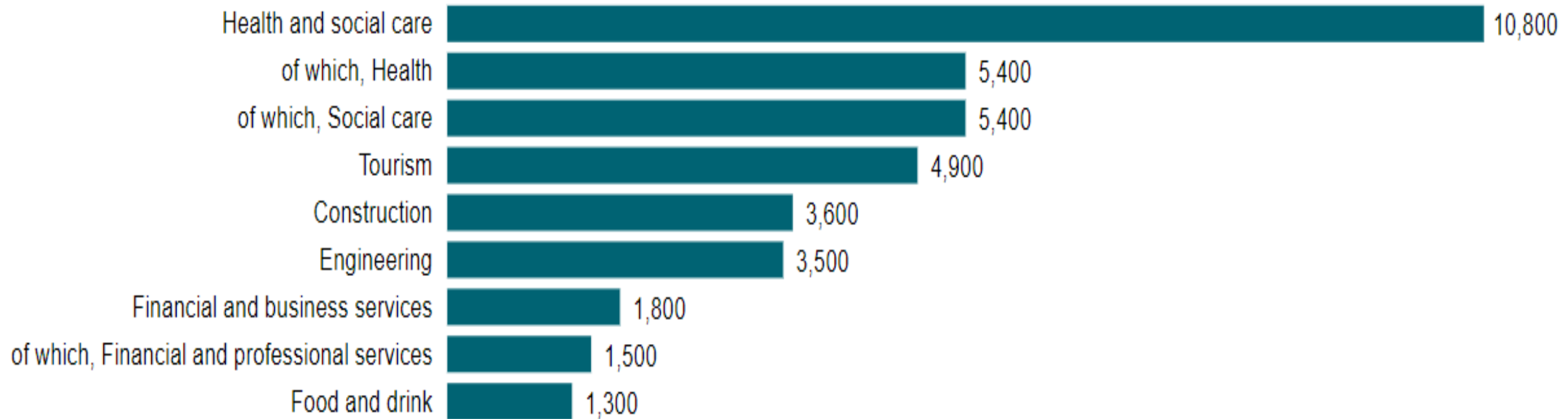
